ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Jerome T. Consiglio lived his life by the guiding principles of dedication to hard work, pursuit of higher education, devotion to the Catholic faith and commitment to family and country. As a first generation Italian American, Jerome was the first member of the Consiglio family to earn a college degree, graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering. During World War II, he served three years in the US Army, Ordinance Corps, as a 2nd Lt. The following years of his life found him in a dedicated 45 year government career, raising a family of 5 children, and volunteering as an usher at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church for over 40 years. In honor of Jerome's commitment to his life's principles, his family established this scholarship in 2011 to award an OLGC parishioner who also embodies these fundamental principles.

The annual scholarship will be an award of \$1,000.00. The award is intended for the use of a High School student to cover tuition and/or university provided room and board. Scholarship recipients are eligible for one year of scholarship support.
